# **PRODUCTION INTERN**

#### What will your role be?

First and foremost, as an intern at Brussels Philharmonic, you will always be a **fully fledged employee** within the team. If you work in the production team, a challenging and fascinating role awaits you. Every week a **new programme** is rehearsed with different combinations of musicians and conductors. There are also **recordings** and **international tours** to prepare for. You need to be as good at making and following **tight schedules** as you are at **setting out chairs** on stage. In other words: you enjoy **rolling up your sleeves and getting stuck in**, and stay calm under pressure. In addition, you will be working every day with our **musicians, conductors and soloists**, who will depend on your cheerful attitude and energetic approach to make the production a success.

Your focus during this internship will be production:

- You will work every day on the practical preparations for our upcoming productions
- You will be a **contact person** for musicians, soloists, conductors and agents, ready to speak in a friendly way with them in several languages
- You will prepare technical data sheets and also take part in technical visits
- You will need to follow up on tasks correctly and accurately, and have no fear of admin
- On concert evenings you will be a reliable backstage helper

- You are very interested in classical music and very hands-on in your approach.
- You are friendly and well organised, you work proactively and function well in a team.
- You have an eye for detail, and aren't afraid of a bit of stress and impending deadlines.
- You are at ease in several languages.
